InspirED: Building the next generation of communicators

The energy was electric at Fitzharrys School as 180 students from across the OX14 Learning Partnership gathered for **InspirED**. Moving away from traditional lectures, the team from Loudspeaker led a high-octane morning of workshops focused on public speaking, networking, and the power of authenticity. From inflatable unicorns to interactive storytelling, students from six different schools connected, laughed, and gained the confidence to use their ‘sincere voices.’ As one participant shared, the day was ‘energising’ and inspired them to be their genuine selves. The second core event of the year, InspirED was an opportunity for students to meet new people, hear from inspiring voices and step outside of their comfort zones.

Academic Coaching

Now in its sixth year, **Academic Coaching** Programme has fostered powerful peer-to-peer connections across the partnership. Over 70 Sixth Formers were trained in the art of the coaching conversation, before being paired with younger students seeking support. Weekly sessions focussed on open questioning to help students work on their personal targets. This unique programme not only provides targeted support and confidence for younger coachees but also equips our Sixth Formers with high level interpersonal skills that are invaluable for university and future careers.

Future Doctors Take the Lead at 'This Isn't Going to Hurt' Medic Day

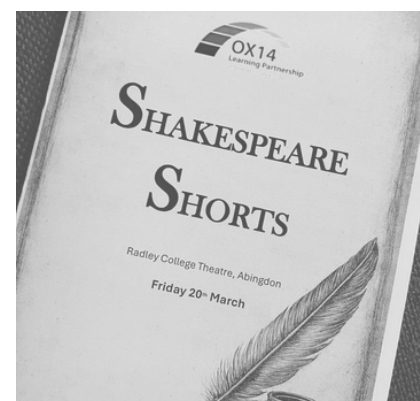

This collaborative event not only sharpened their practical skills but also strengthened their confidence as they navigate the challenging pathways toward medical school.
